## INVITATION

Jundokan New Zealand Inc. is pleased to invite you to participate in the forthcoming Seminar to be held in Kumeu, Auckland, New Zealand from Saturday 19 November to Monday 21 November 2016.

The Seminar will be led and directed by two of the most highly skilled karateka in the world today. Okinawa Masters, Tetsu Gima Sensei and Tsuneo Kinjo Sensei (both 9th degree black belts) are coming to New Zealand to hold this Seminar and to demonstrate, through their own power, knowledge and ability, teachings that will significantly extend your personal karate skills. Based in the kata of Goju Ryu, the Masters will demonstrate bunkai execution that will put life into the kata and ability into your hands. Participation in the Seminar will leave you accomplished, self-assured and confident that you have reached a new level in your karate.

With humility the Okinawa Masters carry the teachings of Chojun Miyagi Sensei, the founder of Goju Ryu Karate some 98 years ago. From 1954 onward, when Eiichi Myazato Sensei was chosen to be the successor of Chojun Miyagi, through to this very day, Goju Ryu is practised in the famous Jundokan dojo in Okinawa. The two Masters that will run the Seminar are prominent in carrying on the heritage and tradition of the Jundokan.

Jundokan New Zealand Inc. will be your hosts for the event and will endeavour to make the Seminar not only a learning experience but memorable as well for the social contact that will most certainly occur.



## PARTICIPATION OVERVIEW

The following is an outline of the format for the training Seminar. We are only able to finalise the format once full details of the registrants are known.

**REGISTRATION** Participants must complete the attached form and comply with the requirements set out. **Places will be limited** to ensure that a good relationship is maintained between the Okinawa Masters and the participants.

**GRADES** Although no particular restriction exists as to grade, it should be understood that the Seminar will focus on advanced karate activity and will rely on the participant to have a solid grounding in the basics of training in their style.

### TRAINING VENUE Kumeu Community Centre, 35 Access Rd, Kumeu.

The venue will be open from 8.30am. Full details will be provided at the Friday evening event. The location is easily found with on site parking. Changing rooms and facilities are available for both female and male. Lunch options are plentiful with many choices within walking distance from the training venue.

Kumeu is a small country setting about 35 minutes from central Auckland. The locality is easily accessed and a pleasant environment. The area is well known for its food produce, quality wine making and nice restaurants.


